HOLLY ROADFELDT, PIANO The musical prelude is often considered an introduction to a larger composition or as the first piece of a suite of other shorter pieces. Chopin's



celebrated 24 preludes altered this perception and this miniature became a significant concert piece on its own. This program includes beloved preludes by Chopin, Rachmaninoff, and Debussy along with several new ones composed in 2014 for Holly Roadfeldt by Kirk O'Riordan, Daniel Perttu, Kala Pierson and Alan Theisen.
